- 1. We do not use cookies or any other technology to track who has been visiting our website. For that reason we do not retain any details from you.
- 2. Our website provider uses cookies that are functional to aid smooth and secure running of the site. We have a cookie banner enable, where users give permission for those cookies to be used.
 - WHAT ARE 'COOKIES'? Cookies are small text files which are downloaded to your computer or mobile device when you visit a website or application. Your web browser (such as Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox or Google Chrome) then sends these cookies back to the website or application on each subsequent visit so that they can recognise you and remember things like personalised details or user preferences.
- 3. When you complete our online "Enquiry form" your details will be seen by the Church Secretary for Cornerstone Baptist Church and might be shared with the Pastor or Leadership team.
- 4. We only store your contact details up to the point that we have dealt with your enquiry, they will be destroyed after that.
